The following are however specially brought to your kind attention:

1. The school shall appoint only qualified and eligible staff.
2. Service agreement be executed with the staff as per norms generally accepted by State Government. A copy of the same be sent to the Board.
3. Service conditions, Pay and allowances and other benefits to the employees of the school shall in no way be less than corresponding salaries of employees working in Government schools of the State concerned.
4. The school will help the Board in the smooth conduct of the examinations by placing the necessary staff & accommodation i.e. Halls, Rooms available in the school premises and furniture at its disposal for holding its examinations free of charge, if required to do so.
5. The school shall remit Rs.100/- as Annual fee regularly by 31st March each year. A copy of the prescribed form for the same is also enclosed.
6. The school and its records shall be open for inspection by an official of the Board or any person authorised by the Board or the State Education Department at any time and the school shall furnish information, as may be asked for by the Board/ State Govt. from time to time.

With reference to your application on the subject cited above; I am directed to convey the approval for Extension of General Affiliation as per details given below:-

In view of current COVID-19 pandemic which has most severely affected the normal functioning of schools in the country, however the school is pursuing to provide extension of affiliation so as to avoid any difficulty for the purpose of admission / registration / admitting / loan/renewal of various safety certificates from appropriate state authorities.

Therefore, the competent authority of the Board after due consideration has accorded approval for extension of Affiliation based on the details/data submitted by school in online application for a further period of 5 years subject to fulfilment of following conditions:-

1. The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and instructions issued thereon by the CBSE/Respective State /UT Govt. from time to time.
 2. The School is required to apply online for further extension of affiliation along with the requisite fee and other documents as per Rule 10.3 of Affiliation Bye Laws, 2018.
 3. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State Government concerned as mentioned in certificate as per appendix III issued by District Education Officer (DEO) /equivalent officer
 4. The school should ensure the strong governance and management of its activities in way of comprehensive and quantifiable planning in way of curriculum planning, infrastructure, resources, physical education, staff development and other co-curricular areas.
 5. The school should go through the provision of Affiliation and Examination Bye Laws and keep a copy thereof for reference purpose and also advised to visit CBSE websites i.e. <http://cbseacademic.nic.in/> & <http://cbse.nic.in/> for updates. The School is expected to see all circulars on these CBSE websites regularly.
 6. The school will strictly adhere to all rules regarding safety of students including Fire fighting and Transportation, etc. Further, School will provide adequate facilities for potable drinking water and clean, healthy and hygienic toilets with washing facilities for Boys and girls separately in proportion to the number of students. The school will ensure that Fire, Building, health and sanitation and safe drinking water certificates are renewed from time to time, as per norms.
 7. Admission to the school is to be restricted as per relevant rules of Examination Bye-laws and rule 2.4.5, 2.6.5, 7.1, 7.2, 8.1, 8.2, 8.4, 10 & other relevant rules of Affiliation bye laws.
 8. The school is required to follow rule No.2.4.7 and 2.4.8 of Affiliation Bye Laws regarding Books and Quality of Educational Material.
 9. The number of sections may be restricted as per the Appendix V of the Affiliation Bye-Laws of the Board. For increase in number of sections, the School shall apply online to the Board as per rule 15.7 of Affiliation Bye laws.
 10. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo, society, trust or any other identity related to running of school affiliated to CBSE. The school shall also be liable to bear all legal charges incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances.
 11. The school must strive to promote conservation of environment on their campus through rain water harvesting, segregation of waste at source, recycling of organic waste, proper disposal of waste including electronic waste, use of energy saving and energy efficient electrical equipment, greening of campus, use of solar energy, education and awareness amongst children on any form of conservation and cleanliness etc.
 12. The school shall submit their information through Online Affiliated School Information System (OASIS) as per details of system and its no. affiliation-06/2018 dated 24.04.2018. Link for OASIS is available on Board's website www.cbse.nic.in/
 13. The optimum Section teacher ratio of 1:1.5 as well as student teacher ratio of 30:1 is to be maintained to teach various subjects and school shall appoint qualified and trained teaching staff on regular basis as per provision of Affiliation Bye Laws of the Board.
 14. Every affiliated school shall sponsor regularly in bonafide and eligible students in Exams Class X and XII of the Board. The school shall inform the year mentioned while granting affiliation/up-gradation regularly without delay on the day of vacancies are there to wait for the time about the non-sponsorship of the candidates.
- Barring of dogging institution in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not permitted by the Board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
- The Manager and the Principal of the school shall be jointly responsible for the authenticity of the online submission of the information by the School to the Board.
